Last month I wrote about the importance of yardage in winter training. Many of you are attending swimming courses and are following a cencentrated training programme, but just as many of you are only having one or two sessions a week of organised swimming. I would like you to pay a couple of additional visits a week to the baths on your own to help your training. Why not go to the baths for half an hour after school, and see how many lengths you can swim in that time? Now that winter is approaching there are less people playing in the water, and it is much easier to swim lengths in a public session - work on the four strokes, do plenty of medleys, some legs on front and back - swim single lengths on butterfly, walking back till you can increase it to 10 x 1½ lengths and then to 10 x 2 lengths. Try it and let me know how you get on.
