Registration

Under A.S.A Law all competitive swimmers aged 10 years (1989) and over are required to register nationally. This applies to anyone who swims in Championships, Meets and Leagues - (I expect you have noticed that your registration number is required on many entry forms.) The charge (an annual one) for this year is £3. It will probably be increased next year and may well be extended to any member of a swimming club. Mrs Knight is collecting registration fees, as these have to be sent in by clubs.

Your Annual Club Subscription

This is due on 1st May - those who swim at the school pool pay £10 with a reduction of £2 for any additional member of the family. This subscription applies whether you swim once a week or several times. Those who only swim at Moseley Road and/or Muntz Street pay £5 a year.

School Pool Admission Payment

For many years this has remained at 20p, but commencing on 1st April it will be increased to 30p. May I remind you that this is solely for the use of the facility. We do not have to pay any coaching fees as our many helpers all give of their time voluntarily. If you study your Swimming Times, you will see adverts for Assistant Club Coaches with a salary of £7,000/10,000. Such a salary, combined with that of a Chief Coach, involves many clubs in having to raise over £20,000 a year. Your admission charge goes to cover the cost of pool hire, which in our case is very reasonable. Even so, I paid a sum of over £2,000 last year so it is essential that you pay your share. This is generally done, but it is rather disconcerting occasionally to find that up to 5 out of 20 swimming are 'short' (ie one quarter of you or one in every four!).

Coach Bookings

This has always been a drain on our resources. We try to keep the individual charge down to £2 per head for a team of 36 plus supporters, which should cover the cost of around £100. If, however, a dozen people prefer to go 'OT' we then have a loss of £24. That is one of the main reasons why we have recently delegated several matches as 'OT' rather than risk losses. We have been fortunate this year in our league venues both in W.M.L & E.M.L in that most have been reasonably accessible.
