Aaron Taylor came near to that sub 70 seconds FLY - a months regular serious training and he'd do it comfortably. Well done also David Tysall and Daniel Finnigan in their first county competition.

Many encouraging swims by the girls also with a crop of good efforts in the 12yr BR including Sally Millard, Flora Lee, Michelle Jennings, Jo Potter, Kearce Finnigan and Kate Green. Two goods swims by Tracey Collier of 1m 24 secs in heat and final of the FLY.

Without a doubt our best swim was Michael Hoare's convincing win in the Mens BR 1.09.78. Advised to swim a "comfortable" heat, Michael still did a P.B. seeming unable to "hold back" but still had plenty left for the final. He had obviously hit top form after a fortnights reduced training - now back to very hard work again!

Relay entries cost the club £104.00 and we well represented in the finals. Congratulations to the Men and Women on winning their Medley Relays for the umpteenth time.

In March he was 2nd at the National Short Course and this earned him selection for several matches. Andrew Wolf was 4th in the 400 IM. Nicky Green swam 2.06.3 in the 200 F/S and was selected for a Junior English team for the 8 Nations Match in Bergamo, Italy. In March we finished 3rd in the final of the London Swimming League. A good set of county results:- 9 Gold, 20 Silver, 19 Bronze. An enjoyable 3 days tour with matches at Bradford Grammer School and Paisley and a mock wedding at Gretna Green. Perhaps our most exciting time was in August at the National Age Group. Linda Brown was 2nd in the 11yr BR 1.29.39; Jackie Evans 3rd 12/13 BK 1.15.20 and Nick Green was in 100/200 FLY finals 16/17yrs. Our 11yr girls Medley Team were 1st 2.32.65 (Kate Long (10), Linda and Caroline Brown, Hayley Bettinson) and 5th in F/S 2.19.01. The girls 12/13 Jackie Evans, Jackie Sheasby, Sarah Cheesbrough and Debbie Clarke were 5th in the Medley and 2nd in the F/S 2.04.15. The above times compare more than well with our present standards. 1974 was our 1st year in the Ladies League Competition.
