Camp Hill 1975

One of our most successful years with many individuals and teams doing well. Water Polo: Mike Hobbs was in a G.B. Team that visited New Zealand and he, Richard Shearby and Mike Feason were in the G.B. u/19 Team for the European Junior Championships in Sweden. Andrew Wolf was 1st in the 400 I.M. in the Midland short course and Adrian Griffiths was Junior F/S Champion in the long course at Coventry. We were 2nd in the E.M.L.. Graham Brookhouse swam the 1500m in a 13/u England Team in Holland. Our Men's F/S Team was 7th in the National Championship. Chris Tainty was 3rd and 7th in the 200 and 100 BK in the National Age Group, going on to swim the 200 in the G.B. Junior Team in Geneva. Andrew Craton was our other National Age Group finalist, 8th in the 100 BR 12/13 years, 1.20.85. We had several P.B.'s and did well in the relays, reaching 9 finals with our best result being 2nd in the boys 12/13 Medley with Glenn Moreton anchoring the team 29.10. The same team was = 3rd in the F/S.

In September, we competed in our first National league final which was won by Cardiff. There were three teams from the Midlands in the first 5 places: Coventry 2nd, ~~C/Hill~~ 4th and Orion 5th. All round strength gained us 4th place, for we only won 4 races: Katie Long 11 year BR 43.10, Chris Tainty and David Beavan and one relay. Maggie Kelly of Cardiff won the "best performance" award for her 1.16.50 in the BR. Now Maggie Hohmann, she swam in the 1988 Olympics at the age of 32!

The year ended on a high note when we qualified for the 1976 National League final by winning the W.M.L. at Nuneaton beating City of Coventry by 31 points.
