A.S.A. LAW CHANGES

There have been three main changes.

- There is now only ONE FALSE START. On the second start, the race will proceed and anyone who has gone early will be disqualified.
- You may now touch with any part of the body on a backstroke turn. You may turn on to the front on the last stroke and do a front somersault, but you MUST be on the back when you push off.
- 3) You are now allowed to go 15m. underwater at the start of a backstroke race, at which point the head must have broken surface.
